## TRACK AND FIELD

Track & Field season is already here and students who enjoy any of the events can take advantage of the change in weather and begin practicing. The school track meet date is posted for grade 4,5 and 6. April 27 and Rain date April 30. Hurdles tryouts and qualifiers will take place during the week of April 23rd and both 800m and 1500m will take place the same week as the track meet.

Events for grades 4 to 8 are 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, hurdles, long jump, triple jump, shot put, standing jump 4-6 only, safety javelin 7-8 only, 100 relay boys and girls, 400m relay grade 7/8 only, and a new co-ed relay.

Grade 2 and 3 students will challenge each other at Bedford Park in track and field events including a sprint, middle distance 2 laps, standing jump, long jump, and a ball throw.
