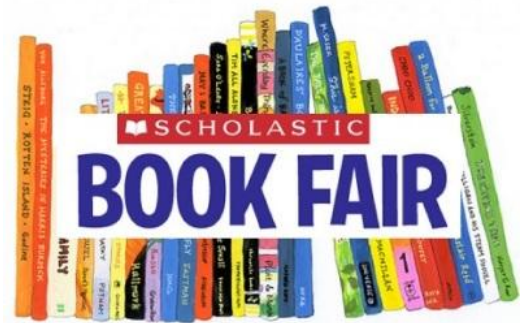

- **Thurs 3:15 to 7:30pm** - All students (after class dismissal), parents & the community are welcome.

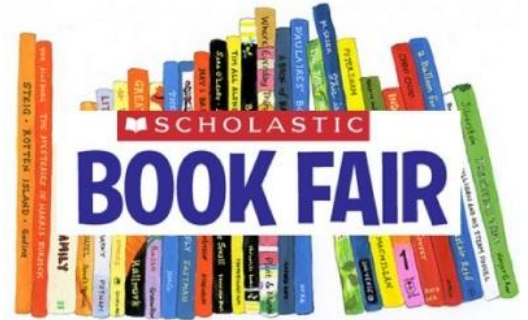
During school time, classroom teachers may have the opportunity to bring their classes down to browse and or purchase.
